The Department of Health is reminding Nunavummiut about the importance of keeping up to date with immunizations. It is especially important that children receive routine immunizations on time to protect them from serious vaccine-preventable diseases.

With measles cases rising across Canada, it is important to protect the most vulnerable members of our families and communities – our children, Elders and those with immune compromise or incomplete immunizations. By ensuring our measles vaccinations are up to date, we can do our part to keep Nunavut healthy and safe from the increasing threat of measles outbreaks.
