The Justice of the Peace Appointment and Remuneration Committee (JPARC) is seeking a public representative to serve on the committee for a three-year term.

JPARC is responsible for making independent recommendations on the appointment and pay of Justices of the Peace in Nunavut. The committee is composed of:

- A member recommended by the Chief Justice.
- A judge of the Nunavut Court of Justice.
- A Justice of the Peace (JP).
- Two public representatives.

One of the public representative positions will become vacant in April 2025, and Nunavummiut are encouraged to apply. The public representatives are entitled to an honorarium for participation based on the current government rates.

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be a resident of Nunavut for at least 12 months.
- Not be an employee of the Government of Nunavut.

Applicants are encouraged to submit a letter of interest to Senior JP Nicole Sikma at ncj.chambers@gov.nu.ca. Applications will be reviewed on an ongoing basis.
