Consumer Affairs is now accepting licence renewal applications for the 2025-2026 fiscal year from the following:

- Businesses such as a profession, trade, manufacture or undertaking that operate outside of municipal boundaries and Nunavut-wide.
- Collection agents and agencies.
- Vendors.
- Direct sellers.
- Employment agencies.
- · Real estate agents and agencies.
- Pawnbrokers and second-hand dealers.

Business licences are valid for a fiscal year, from April 1 to March 31 of every year. Required documentation to apply or renew a licence is listed on the <u>Consumer Affairs</u> website and forms may be requested from Consumer Affairs. Please refer to the <u>License Fee Schedule</u> for applicable fees.
