The Nunavut Food Security Coalition is now accepting funding proposals for projects that will address food insecurity in Nunavut in 2025-26.

Two streams of funding are open for application:

Non-profit organizations, societies, businesses and municipal organizations can apply for funding for:

- 1. Food security projects that:
 - Develop supports targeted to those facing food insecurity.
 - Aim to increase the ability of Nunavummiut to improve their own food security through life and food skills development.
 - Encourage parents and children to learn and build food and life skills together.
 - Reduce barriers to food access and help reduce poverty.

And/or

- 2. Core Funding to:
 - Reduce barriers to food access and help reduce poverty.
 - Contribute to the core operations of a food organization so it is better placed to provide access to services and programming most days of the year and to build food programming beyond emergency food relief.
