Search underway for missing teen in Arctic Bay

The Department of Community Services' Nunavut Emergency Management division is supporting coordinated search efforts for a missing 14-year-old boy in Arctic Bay. This work is being carried out in collaboration with the RCMP 'V' Division, hamlet officials, Canadian Rangers, ground search-and-rescue teams, and community volunteers.

The teen was last seen on June 28, 2025, and was reported missing to local RCMP on June 30, 2025. Search efforts began promptly and have since expanded to include additional trained personnel and logistical support.

The Department extends sincere thanks to the residents of Arctic Bay and all partners involved in the response for their continued efforts.
