Measles vaccine available at Iqaluit walk-in clinic

Nunavummiut can get a measles vaccine during the walk-in clinic held every Friday from 8:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at Iqaluit Public Health (Building 1091, near the old airport terminal). Residents can also call to schedule an appointment from Monday to Thursday. Please bring your immunization records, if available.

The following individuals are encouraged to get vaccinated:

- Anyone 12 months of age and older who has not been fully vaccinated against measles.
- Anyone 6 months of age and older who will be traveling out of territory.
- Individuals born before 1970 who may have some natural immunity to measles but should still consult a healthcare provider to confirm their vaccination status.

If you are unsure about your or your child's vaccination status, please call or visit Iqaluit Public Health, Monday through Friday, to speak with a nurse.
