The Government of Nunavut is committed to community safety and preventing gunrelated harm. On the National Day Against Gun Violence, June 6, we reflect on the importance of responsible firearm use and the role each of us plays in keeping Nunavut safe.

Through <u>Qukiutiliritsiarniq Nunavummi – Firearm Safety Nunavut</u>, the Department of Justice delivers community-based programming focused on education, safety and training. Possession and Acquisition Licence (PAL) courses, licence renewal clinics, and public safety events help reduce the risk of firearm-related incidents across the territory.

Firearm safety is a shared responsibility. By working together, we can help ensure residents feel safe and supported.
