## Call for proposals: Women's Initiatives and Men and Boys' Initiatives grant programs

The Department of Family Services is now accepting proposals for community-based projects that promote women's empowerment and community-based initiatives that provide services and programs for men and boys in Nunavut.

These initiatives and/or projects are to be delivered in the 2025-26 fiscal year and can begin any time after April 1, 2025.

Eligible applicants include community non-profit organizations, municipal corporations and/or individuals associated with an established non-profit organization or municipal corporation.

Project should promote:

- Leadership skills.
- Wellness.
- Economic self-sufficiency.
- Employment.
- Self-reliance.
- Cultural and traditional knowledge.

Applicants must provide proof of current standing with Nunavut Legal Registries, if applicable. The deadline to apply is April 10, 2025. Projects should not exceed \$20,000.
