Are you interested in advocating for victims of crime and supporting programs and policies to assist them? The Department of Justice is looking for representatives from all three regions of Nunavut to serve on the Victim Assistance Committee.

The Victim Assistance Committee, established under the <u>Victims of Crime Act</u>, is a threemember group appointed by the Minister of Justice for a three-year term. Members play a key role in promoting victim services, reviewing project proposals, and making recommendations on applications to the Victim Assistance Fund. The committee may also provide input on policies related to victim services.

Training on roles and responsibilities will be provided to appointed applicants.

The deadline for submissions is April 25, 2025.
