Canadian Free Trade Agreement: call for applications for Nunavut Dispute Resolution Rosters

The Canadian Free Trade Agreement (CFTA) helps to facilitate the free flow of goods, services, investment and workers across Canada. In partnership with the federal, provincial, and territorial governments, the Government of Nunavut (GN) strives to enhance internal trade by ensuring the CFTA meets the evolving needs of businesses and workers.

The GN is seeking qualified individuals to nominate as Government of Nunavut representatives for the Canadian Free Trade Agreement (CFTA) dispute resolution rosters. This includes three distinct rosters:

1. Compliance Panel Roster – up to 5 nominees.
2. Appellate Panel Roster – up to 5 nominees.
3. Annex 309 Panel Roster (Dispute Resolution Relating to Electricity Transmission Services) – up to 2 nominees.

If you have experience in trade, regulatory law, electricity transmission, or administrative dispute resolution, we invite you to apply. Successful applicants will contribute to fair and impartial decision-making in upholding Canada's internal trade agreement.

If selected to serve on a CFTA appellate panel, the member would be required to review case documents, attend any hearings related, and assist in writing the final report. The time commitments will vary depending on the volume of documents related to the case,

the complexity of the case, and length of time of panel hearings. Training will be provided, and panellists will receive an honorarium if they are called to a panel.

Application deadline: June 20, 2025.
