The Department of Community Services' Nunavut Emergency Management Division wants to advise Nunavummiut that the week of May 4-10 is Emergency Preparedness Week across Canada. This year's slogan is "Be prepared. Know your Risks".

There are actions that you can take to ensure you and your family are prepared in case of emergency in your community or on the land.

Preparing your home:

You should always have an emergency kit at home with enough supplies for at least 72 hours. Your emergency kit should include:

- extra water (two litres per person in your home, per day)
- non-perishable food and a manual can opener
- a wind-up or battery-powered flashlight
- a wind-up or battery-powered radio
- extra batteries
- extra medication
- warm clothes
- cash in small bills and coins

Preparations when on the land:
