The Department of Health is seeking members of the public to serve on the Nunavut Midwifery Registration Committee.

The Nunavut Midwifery Registration Committee is mandated by the [Midwifery Profession Act](#) to review and make decisions on applications for licensing and renewal of midwifery practitioners in Nunavut. This committee also advises the Minister of Health on matters of policy, standards and legislation respecting registered midwives in Nunavut.

Prospective committee members should not be registered midwives or employees of the Government of Nunavut (GN).

Applicants should have a strong interest in the regulatory process and be prepared to dedicate two to four hours each month for a teleconference meeting. A knowledge of traditional Inuit midwifery practice is an asset. Incumbents will assist in advancing midwifery professional development, including incorporating traditional midwifery knowledge into practice.
