This pilot program, which runs from April to August, is an important first step towards reducing waste in our community and strengthening collaboration.

- Collect empty aluminum cans (non-alcoholic beverages only).
- Drop off cans at designated collection point (green bin next to the red sealift container in front of Aqsarniit School).
- Encourage friends and family to participate.
- Help spread awareness about recycling.
