Update to Nunavut spill reporting process

Start Date: April 28, 2026

End Date: August 30, 2026

Nunavut-wide

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The Department of Environment is implementing a minor update to how environmental spills are reported in Nunavut. This change is part of a digital platform upgrade aimed at making spill reporting faster, easier, and more accessible.

What is Changing:

- Email submissions will be replaced by a new online Spill Report Webform at <https://www.gov.nt.ca/ecc/en/services/report-spill>

What Remains the Same:

- The 24-hour NWT/NU Spill Report Line remains unchanged.
- To report a spill at any time, call 867-920-8130.

Reporting a Spill (Effective Immediately)

Anyone reporting an environmental spill in Nunavut must:

- Call the 24-hour Spill Line (867-920-8130), or
- Complete the new [online Spill Report Webform](#).

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
