Summer information hub offers in-person help with Nunavut Health Card at Qikiqtani General Hospital

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The Department of Health is offering in-person assistance in Iqaluit to help residents apply for, renew, or replace their Nunavut Health-Care Card, update their mailing address and personal information, and get answers to questions about the application process.

This service is available at Qikiqtani General Hospital (QGH), where a summer student is working alongside the hospital's registration team to provide support. This in-person assistance is also offered at the Iqaluit Post Office in Astro Hill every Tuesday and at Building 615 every Thursday.

The summer student is available to:

- Help residents apply for, renew or replace their Nunavut Health-Care Card.
- Assist with updating mailing addresses and other personal information to ensure cards are sent to the correct address.
- Answer questions about the health-care card application process.

This initiative is part of the department's ongoing efforts to make health-care services more accessible and to help Nunavummiut receive their cards as quickly and efficiently as possible.
