The Nunavut Food Security Coalition is now accepting funding proposals for projects that will address food insecurity in Nunavut in 2026-2027.

Non-profit organizations, societies, businesses, and municipal organizations are invited to apply for funding in the following areas:

1) Food security projects:

- Develop targeted support for those facing household food insecurity.
- Promote Inuit food sovereignty by sharing skills and knowledge of how to safely obtain and/or prepare traditional foods.
- Progress programs that help alleviate poverty.

2) Other food projects:

- Support Nunavummiut in building essential food skills.
- Encourage joint learning of food skills and life skills by parents and children.
- Programs that support hunters.
- Programs working on emergency food access, such as hampers or food vouchers.

3) Core funding:

- Contribute to community food security more broadly by addressing poverty and reducing barriers to food access.
- Support the core operations of food organizations, enhancing their ability to provide consistent services and programming throughout the year.
- Work towards programming that goes beyond emergency food relief.
