Territorial drinking water advisory reminder

June 26, 2026
Nunavut-wide

The Department of Health is reminding residents that as of June 26, 2026, the following drinking water advisories remain in effect. For any advisories posted after this date, please visit the [Government of Nunavut Newsroom](#).

Residents are advised to continue following the recommended safety measures. These advisories have been issued as a safety precaution to protect public health. Communities will be advised when a water advisory is lifted.

Community	Type of Advisory	Date of Notice/Details
Baker Lake	Boil Water	June 10, 2026
Gjoa Haven	Boil Water	January 16, 2026
Pond Inlet	Boil Water	July 17, 2025
Arctic Bay	Boil Water	August 26, 2024
Sanikiluaq	Do Not Consume	Water for consumption must come from the reverse osmosis units installed in each household.
