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The Department of Environment invites all Nunavummiut to take part in Environment Week from June 1-7.

Nunavut Environment Week is held at the same time as Canadian Environment Week and encourages action to protect, preserve and restore our environment. The week includes International Clean Air Day (June 4), World Environment Day (June 5), and World Oceans Day (June 7).

In the spirit of avatittinnik kamatsiarniq, this week is about respecting the land, making mindful daily choices, and sharing knowledge for a more sustainable future. Small actions, like reducing waste, recycling, and conserving energy, help to keep our environment healthy for everyone.

To celebrate, we invite Nunavummiut to nominate someone who has taken action to care for the land and environment. Share what they've done, how it helps the environment, and why their efforts matter to your community.
