



Reporting Staff Housing Emergencies

Nunavut

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All emergencies must be reported by phone. Email is not monitored outside regular business hours and should not be used to report an emergency. Text messages should also not be used in an emergency. Please call the emergency on-call number for your community.

- loss of heat;
- frozen doors;
- lockouts;
- major leaks or plumbing failures;
- fire, after first contacting the Fire Department; and
- vandalism, such as broken windows or forced entry.

Each community has its own emergency on-call phone number. Some numbers may be call-forwarded to an employee's phone, so tenants must call rather than text.



Timely reporting is part of tenant responsibility under the Staff Housing Program. When an emergency is not reported promptly by phone, any resulting damage may be considered tenant-caused.

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
