New medical travel phone at Iqaluit airport

Iqaluit, Nunavut

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The Department of Health has installed a medical travel phone at the Iqaluit airport to help make the medical travel process clearer, safer and more accessible. This phone enables medical travel clients to quickly get support if:

- A flight is delayed.
- Travel plans change.
- They need to contact Iqaluit boarding home.
- Help is needed while at the airport.

This initiative is part of broader efforts to better support Nunavummiut throughout their medical travel journey. The department plans to install dedicated medical travel phone lines at additional airports across the territory over time.

If you are travelling for medical care and need help, please use the medical travel phone at the airport or ask airport staff for assistance.
